

THE END OF AN ERA THE RETIREMENT OF DAPHNE AS CHAIRMAN OF PEEP

It is with a sense of enormous gratitude for her near twenty years of service, tinged with sadness, that your committee must announce the retirement of Daphne McLeod as Chairman of Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice. Daphne will remain on the committee, but at the age of 85 has decided it is time to hang up her boxing gloves.



PRO ECCLESIA ET PONTIFICE IS ABOUT TO EMBARK ON ITS MOST AMBITIOUS PROJECT EVER

PEEP's core mission is to campaign for children in Catholic schools to be properly taught our glorious faith. Unfortunately, with many Catholic schools now staffed by non-Catholics, lapsed-Catholics and even anti-Catholics, not to mention key Boards like the Catholic Education Council and CCRS similarly staffed, and many of our bishops' chanceries infested with radical feminists and other assorted professional dissenters living parasitically off the Body of Christ with the blessing of the bishop, this has proved an impossible task.

Only four out of every hundred children leaving Catholic schools practice their faith into adulthood. Could there be a graver scandal than the fact that Catholic

If you happen to be a teacher, or have teaching experience, especially at primary school level, or are a successful home-schooler, that's a bonus, but it is not essential.

THE MODERNIST IS A CUNNING CREATURE, A DUPLICITOUS SORT ... By: Graham Moorhouse

Someone has cleverly observed that the first casualty of war is truth. One might add that a close second is language, and that is true of both war and revolution.

It is not an accident that the German Nazis for example spoke of the "final solution" rather that speaking of wiping out the Jewish race. It sounds so much less threatening, less evil, perhaps even a tad positive. Similarly, it is no accident that pro-aborts talk about the "products of conception", rather than an unborn child or a foetus: it makes what they are doing seem so much more palatable, less evil, perhaps even a tad bland.

A parallel process is taking place in the post-Conciliar Church. There is a war at the moment between Modernists and Catholics for the soul of the Church. The Modernist has much in common with the sixteenth century reformers, but where he differs radically is in his methodology. Whereas Luther nailed his dissent to the church door at Wittenberg and shouted his foul mouthed defiance from the rooftop, the Modernist prefers to conceal his dissent and work away termite-like to destroy the Church from the inside. There will be no loud, coarse mouthed defiance from him, for the very last thing he wants to do is draw attention to his nasty self.

The Modernist is a cunning creature, a duplicitous sort who deals in nuance; he moves in the shadows, employing familiar words but with an entirely different meaning. And yet his heart is so swollen with pride, so eager for human acclaim that, sooner or later, he can't resist the urge to break cover.

The modernist is like the wolf in the story of Little Red Riding Hood; all is disarming smiles, effusive politeness, inflated bonhomie and never-ending empty prattle about "love". His handshake is always warm, even if usually somewhat unpleasantly limp and moist. When it suits his purpose he will claim that he is recovering a long lost tradition from the early Church, when he wishes to kill-off the same, he will tell us that change is necessary in order to better address the needs of "modern man". Thus, this master of

deceit puts himself in a "Heads I win, tails you lose" situation, all the while claiming only the noblest of motives.

Because the Modernist is highly skilled at concealing his loss of faith, he can be difficult to unmask, but his language will often give him away. Just as when someone talks about the "products of conception", you know immediately that they are a raving pro-abort, similarly, when you hear a prelate talking about the "president" when he means "priest," you know you are dealing with a raving Modernist.

A classic example: Bishop Kieran Conry¹ recently spoke of the need to get people back to celebrating the "Sacrament of Reconciliation." Why do Modernists use convoluted language like "Sacrament of Reconciliation" instead of "confession"? The answer is very simple, they do not believe in sacramental absolution, that smacks too much of the miraculous, and that "magic" stuff is for children. So to conceal his dissent, he has worked out a clever alternative story. It goes something like this: sin is an offence against one's neighbour (he doesn't actually believe in sin as being an offence against God - which may be why men like Archbishop Vincent Nichols can happily pay public homage to Hindu gods). Sin therefore separates me from my neighbour, and consequently puts me outside the community. What is needed therefore is someone with the authority to admit me back into the community. Who better to exercise this authority than the priest (sorry, "president") who has been delegated by the community to take care of community affairs. Thus we are dealing here with a quasi-judicial act, not a sacerdotal one (the Modernists can stomach that - no "magic" involved). Thus, "Sacrament of Reconciliation" because the bloke in charge has readmitted (reconciled) me back into the community.

Occasionally it is not words but their actions that give them away. The Church solemnly teaches that she does not have the power to ordain women. The Modernist, not believing in sacerdotal powers, entirely rationally concludes that anyone, including women, can be appointed by the community to preside. Thus a few years ago you found Bishop Malcolm McMahon taking two Anglican priestesses with him on his diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes and encouraging the faithful to attend their invalid (hence blasphemous) "Masses." He then had both these heretical laywomen

dressed in full clerical glad rags on the altar for his final Mass. This way his lordship can replace our Catholic religion with his own private religion, while cunningly not uttering a single self-incriminating syllable. Bishop Malcolm McMahon is soon to be inflicted on the long-suffering remnant of the once vibrant Catholic diocese of Liverpool. Meanwhile, like stray dogs praising the dog catcher for having tossed them a couple of biscuits, the brain dead are salivating over the fact that his Lordship has occasionally celebrated the Traditional Mass.

Modernists have much in common with the predatory sodomites in the ministry, whose abuse of adolescent boys since the Council has dragged the name of the Church into the mud.: both have no scruples about prostituting their clerical office, or using it as a bully-pulpit, to advance their private agendas, and both use guile and deceit to get away with it, all the while, like that wolf in the story of Little Red Riding Hood, smiling you to death.

The following picture is of a group of traditional Catholics outside Brixton underground giving away rosaries and pitching for the faith. This is a missionary outreach that has come from the laity. Veritas in Via (Truth in

the Street) is a grassroots, non-profit Catholic evangelization organization, dedicated to responding to the mandate of Jesus to preach the Gospel to all nations by taking our Catholic faith into the streets. This in done in a *mostly* non-confrontational way, allowing God's grace to move in the hearts of those who witness our public Catholic presence and engage in conversation with us. The aims are very simple: to open the minds and hearts of non-Catholics to the one true faith, to encourage lapsed Catholics to return to the faith and to encourage neo-Catholics to explore the orthodoxy and orthopraxis of our forefather saints and martyrs. There is nothing "new" about our efforts, perish the very thought, this is just good old fashioned evangelizing.

It's also great fun and God is indeed good, for we have already seen three new attendees at the local traditional Mass resulting from our witness, and it is very early days yet. Indeed, one of these has taken it a step further and joined the Legion of Mary.

YOU ARE NOT WITHOUT POWER

In face of the mass apostasy now taking place in the Church, a silent apostasy reaching right to the very top, it is easy to feel helpless and become despondent. However, there is much that the faithful remnant can do; we are by no means powerless.

The first thing is prayer and fasting. Our Lord said that both were necessary for salvation, and indeed He said that some demons can only be driven out by prayer and fasting. Perhaps, just for example, regularly miss one meal one day a week; and offer it up for Christ's suffering body, the Church.

Every member of the faithful remnant should be saying the Rosary daily. Our Blessed Mother asked for this when she appeared at Fatima, and who are we to ignore or argue with the Mother of God? I would suggest that you don't leave it until the evening, God deserves more than the dregs of the day. No, rise 20 minutes earlier than normal, and say your Rosary before breakfast, or before you start the day.

Know Thine Enemy

In any battle one needs to be able to clearly identify the enemy. Things like the refusal by our bishops to teach the Catholic faith properly to the children in our schools (which remains the primary concern of Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice) are but symptoms. The real enemy is the heresy of Modernism, which since the Council has been released into the Church's bloodstream like a deadly virus. The Modernists, like their master, are masters of cunning and deceit - study them, understand them, learn to recognise them, so that you can unmask them and be on your guard against their venom at all times.

Do not make the silly error of believing that the destruction of the faith in this country was an accident, something for which no one can be held responsible. The demolition of the Catholic faith in England was plotted behind closed doors and carried out with ruthless efficiency by our bishops and their aids, and, with a few glorious exceptions, continues apace. One can be in no doubt that their true Master is well pleased with them.

Knowledge is Power

Read good orthodox books and periodicals explaining and exposing the crisis in the Church. Subscribe to publication like the Remnant (available at http://remnantnewspaper.com/web/index.php) and Christian Order (available at http://www.christianorder.com/subscribe.html). The fortnightly Irish Catholic paper, *The Catholic Voice*, is another edifying read and is available in some churches.

Avoid like the plague the Universe, Catholic Times and the Tablet - the constant drip drip of Modernist propaganda can seriously damage your spiritual life and chances of salvation.

Indeed, if you see the Tablet on sale in your church, you should remove it and bin it. Anti-Catholic propaganda has no right to be on sale in our churches. That is not what we and our forefathers built and maintain our churches for.

Don't become just another useful idiot, helping to destroy the faith through false obedience

Satan's masterstroke is to have succeeded in sowing disobedience to the faith and tradition through false obedience to authority. Those holding to this error believe that the Church's hierarchy has absolute authority and therefore obedience to Church leaders has no limits. Those leaders consequently command whatever they want even when they contradict God's Law by abandonment of Tradition and the Faith. Anyone who criticizes them or protests against what they say or do is labelled as Protestant or schismatic (or insane!) and can even expect unjust punishment: witness the Franciscan Friars of the Immaculate.

Unexamined obedience is one of the Modernist's prime weapons against the Mystical Body of Christ. It is important to understand the moral virtue of obedience in order to avoid false obedience, because Modernists abuse this false obedience of the faithful to destroy the Church.

Obedience is a supernatural moral virtue which inclines a person to submit his will to that of a *lawful* superior. But the authority of the superior shares in the authority of God and therefore obedience rests in the final analysis on the submission each person owes to God. God alone has the right to demand absolute obedience from us.

St. Thomas Aquinas warns of excess in obedience in so far as a man obeys whom he ought not, or obeys in matters wherein he ought not to obey (IIa IIae, Q.104, 2, ad 2). St. Thomas further explains: man is subject to God as regards all things, and is bound to obey God in all things. On the other hand, we are not subject to our superiors in *all* things, but only in *certain* things and in a *particular* way, and only so far as the superior stands between God and his subjects (IIa IIae, Q.104, 5, ad2).

The lawful superiors, such as the Pope, are to be respected as representatives of Christ but they are not infallible in most of what they say or do and, if they depart from Christ's teaching, we should not follow them. Pope Leo XIII in *Diuturnum Illud* wrote:

"There is no reason why those who obey God rather than men should be accused of refusing obedience, for if the will of rulers is opposed to the will and the laws of God, these rulers exceed the bounds of their own power and pervert justice, nor can their authority be valid, which, when there is no justice, is null."

It is through obedience to God and not to false shepherds that His Kingdom will come on earth as it is in heaven. When they said to St. Athanasius: "You have all the bishops against you," he replied: "This shows that they are all against the Church." "The Catholics faithful to the Tradition, even if reduced to a handful of people, are the true Church of Jesus Christ."

True obedience, therefore, is subject to Faith and Tradition and if a superior or bishop demands anything contrary to them, a Catholic has the <u>duty</u> to refuse to obey. No one owes obedience to traitors.

Letter writing

Never tire of letter writing. Write regularly to papers, bishops, priests and Roman congregations. Sadly, with the Church from top to bottom infested with Modernists, it is rare that your letters will bear immediate fruit, but it is important that the powers that be know that there are many faithful Catholics who see through their machinations and refuse to be cowed into silence.

Starve them of cash

Be very prudent when it comes to putting money into second collections and suchlike. Certainly don't give money to corrupt organisations like CAFOD. But if the collection is for the diocese, and your diocese is run by bureaucracies staffed by radical feminists, homophiles and other assorted dissenters, why on earth would you want to give then a penny of your hard earned money? If they are collecting for a Catholic education system that is destroying the faith of our children, why on earth, if you truly love our Blessed Lord, would you want to give such demonic enterprises money?

Don't only refuse to give them money yourself, encourage others to follow your example. Genuine Catholics who give these people money are like turkeys organising a whip-round for Christmas.

The Mass of our forefathers, saints and martyrs

Attend the traditional Mass, if you can, at least occasionally. The traditional Mass is to Modernists what holy water is to the possessed, it makes them grind their teeth and convulse with irrational rage.

If you can't find one within a reasonable commuting distance, contact the Latin Mass Society and see if you can be of help in campaigning for one in your area.

Shun practises imposed on us by Modernists

We must shun all those novelties imposed on us by Modernists; Communion in the hand standing, not fasting before Communion, receiving Communion from laymen, invading the Sanctuary and distributing Communion when the priest is capable of doing it himself. These are all practices introduced by Modernists to reduce reverence for sacred things and spaces. Become a soldier of the true faith, not just another useful idiot mindlessly doing the Modernists' dirty work for them.

Guerrilla Warfare

We must recapture some of the militancy for Christ of our forefathers. Bishop Saint Nicolas of Myra (the proto-Father Christmas and apostle of charity) at the Council of Nicea famously punched the heretic Arius in the mouth. Would disgraceful prelates like Vincent Nichols be as keen to lay on special blasphemous tailored liturgies for the treacherous "Catholic" wing of the militant sodomite collective if he knew he was going to get smacked in the mouth (metaphorically speaking) by 10,000 genuine Catholics?

Until God restores a proper Catholic hierarchy in our homeland, we are in effect reduced to a faithful remnant fighting a guerrilla war. Guerrilla warfare is a form of irregular warfare in which a small group of combatants such as armed civilians or irregulars use military tactics including ambushes, sabotage, raids, petty warfare, hit-and-run tactics, and extraordinary mobility to fight a larger and less-mobile traditional army - I am here of course talking metaphorically, but I would hope I wouldn't need to add that.

In the final analysis, we are in the best kind of army in the best kind of war. We fight for a cause that we cannot lose. I'm certain of it. Has not Our Lady promised us that, "in the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph"? Cling to this truth and put any thought of despair behind you. With God on our side, one is a majority.

"ONLY FOUR PERCENT OF THOSE WHO ATTEND 'CATHOLIC' PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE UK REMAIN IN THE CHURCH IN ADULTHOOD"

[Editor's Note: Many of you may wonder why before the Council, 80% of children leaving Catholic schools practiced their faith, while today only 4% do - and many of those who do could best be describes as Roman Protestants.

The following first-hand report from a Flock reader who signed up for CCRS course should remove the scales from the eyes of anyone still deluding themselves that this is an accident. The CCRS (Catholic Certificate in Religious Studies) is managed and awarded by the Board of Religious Studies on behalf of the Bishops' Conference. It has been skilfully designed by the CHaPs (Catholics Hating Prelates) who have appropriated English sees to ensure that Catholic schools do not pass on the Catholic faith. In this objective it has been extraordinary successful.

Imagine if a Jewish rabbi was to have accidentally stumbled into the gay bar in Munich where many of the earliest meetings of the Nazi Party took place. Conjure in your mind's eye how the atmosphere would have immediately turned icy and palpably changed to one of aggression, intimidation and hostility. Then ask yourself why the atmosphere at a CCRS meeting, an official organ of the Catholic bishops conference, turns immediately sour and unwelcoming when an orthodox Catholic is discovered in their midst? Are we not witnessing here something manifestly diabolical?

Then further ask yourself: why your bishop is routinely appointing such hard-line anti-Catholics to key diocesan posts? This has been going on now for decades in many of our dioceses, so wake up and smell the coffee. "But he that shall scandalize one of these little ones that believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone should be hanged about his neck, and that he should be drowned in the depth of the sea." Matthew 18:06

Welcome to yet another of the "Tales of CCRS". One of the teaching days on the Westminster CCRS course I attended was specifically for teachers in 'Catholic' (you'll see why I place it in parentheses as we go along) diocesan schools, mostly primary schools as it turned out, but with a few from secondary. The theme of the day was "What makes a successful Catholic School?"

One of the first things I noticed was that, in line with the feminisation of education in general and the primary sector in particular, all the teachers were women. That would be the same these days anywhere in the country at a gathering of primary teachers.

The day was led by a logic, reason and historical knowledge challenged Deputy Head (soon to become a Headmistress, Lord help us!). However, I want to focus on the other course participants and the jaw-dropping ignorance of the Faith, promotion of heresy, error and apostasy and the self-serving cowardice they collectively displayed.

Let's get a few things straight first of all: You do not have to be a Catholic to teach in a 'Catholic' school. If you are a Catholic, you do not have to uphold the Faith, live the Faith or have even a modicum of knowledge and understanding of the Faith.

Families do not have to be Catholic to send their children to 'Catholic' schools. In many, especially, but not only, inner city 'Catholic' schools, children from Catholic families are in a minority; non-Catholic and especially Muslim pupils make up the majority in an ever increasing number of them.

Many of the 'Catholic families' that send their children to 'Catholic' schools do not attend Mass and indeed have no faith life whatsoever. Many are single-parents, unmarried or divorced and "remarried". Most are using contraception and are pro-aborts.

Are you depressed yet? Well, hold on, it gets much worse! While there are so many things I could say about the teachers I met that day, it is important to bear in mind that they are an absolutely representative sample of the people running our diocesan schools and the three most basic and crucial things I can point out that should utterly convince you to Home School at all costs are:

- 1. These people have no commitment to the Faith, nor indeed knowledge or understanding of it. Put simply, they are unbelievers.
- 2. They are, quite literally, incapable of grasping objective truth and, in fact, reject it out of hand.
- 3. As if 1 and 2 above were not bad enough, they are actively and hysterically aggressive, antagonistic and insulting to anyone who points out the truths of the Faith and their logical ramifications.

I will not give chapter and verse of the many exchanges I had throughout the day, it would be tiresome and long-winded in the extreme. The notable thing was that, as soon as it became clear by my comments and suggestions that I am an orthodox, traditional Catholic, it was obvious I made most (if not all) of the other course participants and the course leader uncomfortable, and

many of them made their dislike of me and my Catholic attitudes abundantly clear.

The state of 'Catholic' schools (Primary and Secondary) can be illustrated by the following points, all of which are real responses, views and official policies I read and heard on the day - I am not making up any of this:

- It may not be said or taught at any time and in any context that the Roman Catholic Church is the One True Faith.
- All religions and faiths are equally valid and worthy of respect.
- Sodomite 'marriage' is to be celebrated and approved of.
- Children are "sexual beings" from an early age and sexual experimentation and questioning are to be encouraged and accepted.
- There is no such thing as "normal" in terms of sexuality, marriage or family structure; these things are fluid, changeable and not subject to any fixed morality.
- There is no such thing as absolute Truth; truth is relative.
- There is no such thing as objective morality; morals are relative.
- One's own conscience is the ultimate guide, not a fixed system of rules "imposed upon us by a patriarchal Church".
- As long as one has love and good intention, one need not attend Mass.
- The Eucharist is symbolic.
- The Koran is a holy book.
- Islam is a religion of peace.
- Hell does not exist.
- Satan does not exist.
- All people are saved.
- There is no such thing as sin (apart from being "judgemental", of course!).
- The Labour Party is the champion of the "Poor and Oppressed".
- The European Union is an unalloyed good.
- The United Nations is an even bigger unalloyed good.
- Abortion is a woman's choice; no patriarchal "Church run by celibate old men" can have anything of value to say on the matter.
- Contraception is a really, really good thing (no patriarchal "Church run by celibate old men" has anything of value to say on the matter).

I will mention just one specific interaction I had with two of the course participants, because it goes to the very root of the rot and corruption we see

in 'Catholic' schools; the inability or refusal to grasp the meaning of objective truth.

I was in a discussion with two of the Primary school teachers and I was trying to explain to them that their just expressed belief that "There is no such thing as absolute truth, truth is relative" was:

- 1. Inherently self-contradictory and nonsensical because the statement, "There is no such thing as Absolute Truth..." purports itself to be an absolute truth statement.
- 2. Inherently pointless and self-defeating because, even if one ignores the above, and accepts the statement at face-value, the statement has no meaning or purchase on reality because, by the statement's own terms, it has no right to be accepted as truth.
- 3. By definition, an abandonment of morality, an open door to every vice and perversion fallen human nature can conjure and an acceptance of "Might makes Right".
- 4. A denial of God; since God is the Absolute Truth and all Truth descends from him.

I spent a significant amount of time clearly and logically expressing these points and giving examples and similes to illustrate them beyond any ambiguity. It was perfectly plain that neither of them had any counter to any of the points I made (because they are logically and irrefutably true) so the way they chose to end the interaction was to say (in their best talking-to-child-with-learning-difficulties-voice), "Well, that's your opinion" ... I was, quite literally, speechless.

While I strongly urge as many people as can to home school, I do realise that it's just not possible for everyone. The next best thing is to find a secular, non-Catholic school, and take care of your children's faith formation yourself (it is your responsibility anyway). Your children will have a much better chance of learning and loving the Faith that way and staying faithful into adulthood, whereas, if they go to 'Catholic' Primary and Secondary schools, they will have their faith destroyed by the faithless, stupid, ignorant and cowardly teachers therein.

Only four percent of those who attend 'Catholic' Primary and Secondary schools in the UK remain in the Church into adulthood, a 96% failure rate. Perhaps you will now have a better understanding of why that is so

The History of the Rosary

As early as the ninth century, Irish monks recited the 150 psalms from the Bible as part of their daily devotions. The laity wanted to associate themselves with this pious devotion, but it was impossible because, until the invention of the printing press, it was not possible for most people to own a Bible.

So a "compromise" was reached: the laity would recite the Lord's Prayer 150 times a day, once for each psalm. But some means was needed to keep count. People initially used a piece of string with 50 knots in

it that they counted three times; this evolved into the Rosary of fifty beads we have today."

"Are Non-Catholic Churches True Churches?"
